

**Clark R. Gregg, MD  
Chief of Staff**



Clark R. Gregg, MD, was selected Chief of Staff at VA North Texas Health Care System (VANTHCS) in November 2006. In this role, he is responsible for medical facilities located in Dallas and Bonham and the Fort Worth Outpatient Clinic which provide acute care, intensive care, telemetry unit, emergency care, operating rooms, spinal cord injury center, dialysis unit, primary and specialty outpatient clinics, acute and domiciliary psychiatric programs, and nursing home care.

Prior to this appointment, he served as Chief of Medical Service at VANTHCS and Professor of Medicine and Vice-Chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, Texas. In these roles, Dr. Gregg has had frequent interactions with physician staff, house staff, fellows, and medical students and devoted much of his time and energy to teaching. He received the Outstanding Teacher Award from the Internal Medicine House Staff in 2004.

Dr. Gregg graduated magna cum laude from Rice University and received his medical degree from the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas. He did his residency in Internal Medicine and a research and clinical fellowship in Infectious Diseases at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. He served as a General Medical Officer in the US Air Force during the Vietnam War before returning to the faculty at Vanderbilt. He joined VANTHCS as a staff physician in Infectious Diseases in 1993 and became Section Chief of Infectious Diseases then Chief of Medical Service.

He is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians and serves as the Statewide At-Large Director of the Board of Directors of the Texas Academy of Internal Medicine (Texas Chapter of the American College of Physicians). He is also a Fellow of the Infectious Diseases Society of America and is past president of the Texas Infectious Diseases Society. Dr. Gregg is a member of American Society for Microbiology, Texas Club of Internists, Society for Healthcare Epidemiology of America, and Association of VA Chiefs of Medicine.

Dr. Gregg encourages medical research as a member of the VANTHCS Research and Development Committee and Board of Directors of the Dallas VA Research Corporation. He has served on the editorial board or reviewer for several medical journals. His professional interests include gastrointestinal infections, molecular epidemiology, mycotic infections, drug interactions, and formulary management.
