VETERANS CAN USE TYLER VA FOR CARE

TYLER – The Tyler VA Primary Care Clinic is the newest VA North Texas Health Care System (VANTHCS) facility. Initially a contracted clinic with a local provider, last May the Tyler VA became all VA-staffed.

This transition has provided veterans in Smith, Camp, Henderson, Van Zandt, Rains and Wood counties a full continuum of VA health care services including primary care, mental health services and specialty consults. The clinic has three full time physicians, one part time physician and a fee contract physician. Mental health services are also available, as well as social worker, advanced practitioner nurse, mental health nurse, and psychologist. The Tele-mental health program enables psychiatrists at Dallas VA Medical Center to conduct face to face counseling with Tyler patients via video conference, and routine radiology exams are provided under contracted services near the clinic.

The clinic located at 3414 Golden Road in Tyler saves many veterans a long trip and travel expense to Dallas for care, and any eligible veteran can use Tyler VA Primary Care Clinic.
