Peter Dancy was appointed Associate Director of VA North Texas Health Care System on March 25, 2012. Mr. Dancy is responsible for managing the areas of Logistics, Engineering, Human Resources, Pharmacy, Prosthetics, Health Information Management Services and Fiscal.

Mr. Dancy formerly served as the Associate Director of the Edward Hines, Jr. VA Hospital in Chicago from 2010-2012. He also served as the Co-Chair of the VISN 12 Emergency Preparedness Advisory Council responsible for overseeing the system's emergency preparation, mitigation and response efforts.

Mr. Dancy entered the Department of Veterans Affairs in 2010 after serving as Associate Administrator (Chief Operating Officer) of Ben Taub General Hospital, a 597-bed teaching hospital in Houston, Texas. Prior to that, he spent more than 22 years in the Army retiring in 2006 at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

Mr. Dancy is a board certified health care executive and Fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives. He previously served with the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care as an ambulatory health care surveyor.
