

## Education

VA North Texas Health Care System (VANTHCS) is a major educational resource, providing clinical and administrative training in a broad range of



health care professions and occupations to approximately 2,000 students. VANTHCS has affiliation agreements with over 100 agencies and institutions, and the longstanding partnership between VANTHCS and The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas (UT

Southwestern) is especially significant. Staff physicians and service chiefs at Dallas VA Medical Center (VAMC) serve as faculty members at UT Southwestern.

As a primary teaching hospital for UT Southwestern, over 700 medical residents and eight dental residents from Baylor College of Dentistry received training at Dallas VAMC.

VANTHCS provides training for students in Allied Health Education, including Biomedical Communication, Blood Bank Technology, Clinical Nutrition, Social Work Service, Gerontology and Geriatric Services, Medical Laboratory Sciences, Nursing, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Rehabilitation Science (Blind Rehabilitation), and Prosthetics and Orthotics. VANTHCS also is a major training site for the University of North Texas Health Sciences Center, Texas Woman's University, and Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center School of Pharmacy.

Partnering with educational institutions provides VANTHCS an avenue to mentor students, share knowledge and expertise, introduce prospective health care providers to the veteran population, and recruit qualified professionals to our campus.
