

Fort Worth Outpatient Clinic

Open since 1992, Fort Worth Outpatient Clinic (FWOPC) offers general and specialty outpatient care in medicine, surgery, and mental health. Striving to improve access to care, FWOPC provides medical services to veterans in the western primary service area of VA North Texas Health Care System. Patients who require hospitalization or more sophisticated outpatient care are referred to Dallas VA Medical Center.



Enhanced outpatient services reduces the need for more expensive and stressful emergency procedures.

Services include primary care, ambulatory surgery, dental, nutrition, physical therapy, audiology, eye services, ear, nose and throat, mental health, podiatry, orthopedics and urology. Laboratory, radiology, pharmacy and social work services are also available. In addition, representatives from Disabled American Veterans, Military Order of the Purple Heart, Texas Veterans Commission, and Veterans Benefits Administration are located on campus.

A 41,640 net square-foot facility supports a staff of approximately 110, including physicians, nurses, pharmacists, technicians, and administrative support along with active volunteers and work study students.

FWOPC has outgrown its present location, and a new 218,000 square foot clinic is scheduled to open in 2009 that will be the largest leased clinic within VA.
